## A MESSAGE FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER, KEVIN EASON

## AUG/SEPT

## 2022

Most area schools will start back during the month of August. This means school buses will be in StillWaters to pick up children early in the mornings and will return in the late afternoons to drop them off. Please pay attention while driving in StillWaters during school bus times. It is illegal to pass a school bus that is stopped to pick up and unload children.

Several owners have contacted the SWRA office concerned about the delay in the road work scheduled for this year. As we mentioned in the last newsletter, the scope of work has been approved, the contractor has been selected, and budgeted funds have been set aside to pay for the road work. In order to reduce the cost of the project, SWRA worked out an agreement with the road contractor that allows them to work on the StillWaters project while they are working on a larger project in the StillWaters vicinity. This saves SWRA about 10% on the total overall cost. The trade-off is that the work in StillWaters is completed when there are gaps in the work schedule of the larger project. We ask that owners be patient, the road and drainage repairs are starting soon.

The 1,500 owners who receive the SWRA *eflash* received a request in June to take a survey asking if they were interested in a roving security patrol for StillWaters and if they would be willing to pay a voluntary fee of \$50 per year starting in 2023 for the security patrol. We had a great response to the survey with 41% of the recipients taking the survey. Several owners contacted the office inquiring about the survey because they do not have an email or use the internet. Included in this newsletter is a paper survey owners can complete and return to the SWRA office. Owners who took the online survey will not be counted again if they return a paper survey. In order for the survey to be counted, owners must complete the name information on the survey. An anonymous survey will not be considered. Please read the Security Patrol article in this newsletter.

We had a great turnout for the July 4<sup>th</sup> golf cart parade. The parade started with 26 carts and ended with 28 carts; a couple of carts joined the parade while in progress. Many thanks to Dave and Patti Reaves for helping revive the golf cart parade for the last two years. We hope next year will be even larger.

New security cameras have been installed at the StillWaters main pool. These new cameras cover the whole pool area, including the parking lot. Now anyone entering the pool area or vehicles that are parked in the parking lot will be caught on camera. The pool can now be monitored remotely 24/7. The new cameras have already helped reduce the number of incidents at the pool.

Please remember if you drive a Low-Speed Vehicle (golf cart, side by side, or another type of small motorized vehicle) on StillWaters roads, you must register that vehicle with the SWRA office and a permit will be issued for that vehicle. All LSVs must have brake lights, turn indicators, rearview mirrors, and headlights. ## STILLWATERS SECURITY PATROL UPDATE



Thank you to everyone that took the security patrol survey in the last newsletter. We had a very good response to the survey with the majority of respondents indicating they would voluntarily pay an additional \$50 per year to help fund a roving security patrol. For those property owners who did not receive the digital survey, a paper survey is included in this newsletter. Please complete it and return it to the SWRA office.

The SWRA Board is still working on determining the best option for a security patrol in StillWaters and if a security patrol will be feasible. The main

issue is the cost. To provide a security patrol for five days a week with a 40-hour work week the minimum cost when you factor in insurance, taxes, equipment cost, etc. has been estimated to be \$50,000 for the first year.

In order to fund a security patrol at least 1,000 of the 1,946 property owners in StillWaters must pay the proposed volunteer fee of \$50 in addition to their 2023 annual fee. Should SWRA fall short of the estimated \$50,000, those that paid the fee will receive a refund or credit.

The proposed security patrol will be mostly during evening hours. The hours and days of patrol will rotate. The security patrol will not be 24/7. It will mainly be during the most active hours beginning in the afternoon and ending around midnight, five days a week including weekends. The hours of patrol may increase provided there is available funding.

A security patrol should help reduce the increased vandalism of common and personal property we have experienced over the last year. Owners will be able to contact security when they have an issue such as loud neighbors, fireworks, contractors working on Sunday, etc.

## SHERIFF DEPUTY PATROL IN STILLWATERS

The SWRA Board approved additional funding to hire off-duty county deputies to patrol the StillWaters roads for a limited time. This patrol was during the months of July and August. Although this was not a budgeted item for 2022, the SWRA Board decided it was in the best interest of the community to help reduce vandalism, speeding on the roads, and reckless driving.

The presence of the deputies was very successful. No vandalism was reported on their patrol dates and it appeared traffic moved at a slower pace.
