#### STILLWATERS COMMUNITY SERVICES PATROL

School is almost out, and Memorial Day is not far away, followed by the 4<sup>th</sup> of July, ending with Labor Day. Take a big breath, relax, and oh no it's Football Season! What is the one thing that all of these events have in common? A major influx of people coming to StillWaters for getaway weekends, week-long vacations, and those fun-loving, tailgating, enthusiastic War Eagle and Alabama fans.

Unfortunately, with all the hype comes loud noises, heavy traffic, illegal parking, alcohol, overcrowded pools, golf carts, speeding vehicles, and sometimes other unwanted behavior in the community.

In June/July of 2022, the StillWaters Board of Directors considered the possibility of establishing a regular StillWaters Patrol for the community in conjunction with the few off-duty Sheriff Deputies hired for busy holiday weekends. Funding of the program became an issue because StillWaters' governing documents do not allow for the SWRA annual fee to be increased enough to cover large additional programs. The Board then decided to ask StillWaters' owners to support the payment of a voluntary annual fee of \$50 per property to be used for the addition of a StillWaters' Security Patrol starting in 2023 and should the SWRA fall short in raising the funds, then the \$50 fee would be refunded back to the owners who had made the voluntary contributions.

StillWaters' owners were asked to take a brief email survey to see if owners had any interest in additional patrols. The results of the survey showed the following:

- 80% of StillWaters' owners knew StillWaters did not provide security throughout the community.
- 69% of StillWaters' owners would like to see a regular security patrol in StillWaters.
- 17% of StillWaters' owners experienced a need for a security patrol.
- 65% of StillWaters' owners would be willing to pay an extra \$50 per year for a security patrol.

Congratulations StillWaters' Owners, YOU DID IT! StillWaters' Owners voluntarily contributed \$71,000 to cover the expenses of adding a Security Patrol to the SWRA Community.

Hello Folks, my name is "Griff" Griffin, Association Manager for StillWaters. When I arrived in February 2023, the Board of Directors had a long list of items that needed to be addressed. One of those items was to establish a new community patrol for StillWaters. It has been an exciting process to see this new program take shape in preparation for the 2023 vacation season starting with the Memorial Day Holiday weekend on May 26<sup>th</sup>. Chief Deputy Fred White and Sergeant Joe Cowart with the Tallapoosa County Sheriff's Department have been very instrumental in assisting me with the development of this new program. They will also assist with the classroom training for the employee(s) involved in this program.

One of the first things we needed to do was give this new program a name. After many, many days, the Board agreed on the name "Community Services Patrol" (CSP). We were careful not to reflect that we were a licensed security company with security guards. The function of our "Patroller(s)" is to Assist, Observe, and Report.

Some of the CSP responsibilities:

- Patrol property regularly to establish a presence and maintain order.
- Enforce SWRA community rules, policies, and regulations.
- Be aware of the surroundings, looking for and observing unusual or suspicious behavior and/or activity. If the need arises, call Tallapoosa County Sheriff's Department (TPCSD).
- Monitor suspicious vehicles and people and document all suspicious activities, Keep a regular appearance in specific areas of the community, drive-by of residents' homes, condominiums, townhomes, pickle ball courts, playground, pool, etc.
- Responsible for patrolling 23 miles of roadways in StillWaters Community always keeping a watchful eye for vehicles speeding through the community.
- SWRA Community Patroller DOES NOT have the power or authority of Sheriff's Deputies, but they will work closely with local and county Law Enforcement Agencies.
- It is the responsibility of the patroller to try and de-escalate incidents while communicating with residents and/or guests. Such as someone parked in the wrong place, the group making too much noise, or someone that has had way too much to drink. If the situation goes from good to bad, back away and call Tallapoosa County Sheriff's Department.

We are getting close to putting the Community Services Patrol on the road. A new (used) vehicle is being serviced, and new logos and lettering are being applied to the patrol vehicle. The CSP vehicle is equipped with safety & warning lights, and the vehicle will carry necessary supplies & safety equipment as well.

Community Services Patrol has its own cell phone number (256) 496-9324, to report Patrol-related issues only. This number will be on the Patrol Vehicle. Currently, the number is not being monitored, if there is an issue or problem contact the StillWaters Residential Association Monday – Friday during normal business hours, after hours contact Mike Dean, Associate Association Manager (256) 496-8775 or Griff Griffin, Association Manager (256) 496-7716. For immediate medical issues or Tallapoosa County Sheriff's Department issues DIAL 911.

We are currently interviewing candidates for the Patroller position. Once candidates are selected, they will attend a classroom course outlining the expectations of the Patroller position, safety guidelines, and how to handle various situations. This course will be given by Chief Deputy Fred White and Sergeant Joe Cowart of the Tallapoosa County Sheriff's Department. We are so very appreciative of the support shown by Sheriff Jimmy Abbott and Deputy Chief Fred White in assisting with the development and rollout of StillWaters Community Services Patrol.

I am hoping that on May 15th we can start patrolling to get the patroller acclimated to the community and be prepared for Memorial Day weekend.

### **MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND**



Memorial Day weekend is usually the busiest weekend of the year in StillWaters. Please be courteous to your neighbors and guests. Parking can be difficult so make sure you park in a designated parking space and inform your guests that an illegally parked vehicle may be towed or booted. There will be a higher-than-normal number of people walking, running, and riding bikes on StillWaters roads. Please remember to drive safely and the speed limit in StillWaters is 20mph unless otherwise posted.

# NEW DEVELOPMENT IN STILLWATERS

Construction has started on a new development named Eagle Ridge on Moonbrook Drive. A developer has purchased a large tract of land that fronts Moonbrook and borders the golf course. The developer has plans to build several new homes in this area. There will be





increased construction vehicles along Moonbrook for the next year. Please drive carefully when traveling along Moonbrook as you enter and exit StillWaters. The speed limit on Moonbrook is 35 mph.

### REGISTER YOUR GOLF CART/UTV

Please remember all golf other and similar carts vehicles (side-by-side UTVs, must be registered etc.) with the **SWRA** office to operate on StillWaters roads. Anyone driving a golf cart or similar vehicle on StillWaters roads must valid driver's possess a license and the golf cart/ UTV must meet the SWRA vehicle requirements.

#### SWIMMING POOL USE



Pineview pool is now open!! Temperatures are now warm enough for most people to enjoy a dip in the swimming pool. If you use one of the provided pool umbrellas, please remember to lower it when you leave. StillWaters' property owners may use the Pineview pool located adjacent to the SWRA Centre parking lot at 1816 StillWaters Drive. To enter the pool area, you must first obtain an electronic pool gate card from the SWRA office. All 1987 covenant property



owners who are in good standing with SWRA can obtain a pool card from the SWRA office. All 1971 covenant property owners and all 1974 amendment property owners who have paid the annual \$100 amenity fee can also obtain a pool card. If you are not a 1987 covenant property owner or you are under the 1971 covenants or the 1974 amendments and have not paid the annual amenity fee, you cannot use the Pineview pool. There are several pools located at the different condominium complexes throughout StillWaters. These pools can only be used by unit owners at each particular condominium complex. Non-condominium owners cannot use a pool located at any of the condominium complexes unless they are a guest of the condominium unit owner. The condominium associations are enforcing pool usage rules by removing unauthorized people from their pools and contacting the Sheriff's department when unauthorized people refuse to leave their pools. Some of the condominium association pools require anyone entering the pool to wear the association pool wristband.

# SWRA 2023 WINDOW DECALS

By now all property owners should have their blue 2023 StillWaters Property Owner window decal displayed on the driver's side of their vehicle's front window to enter StillWaters without being stopped by the gate attendant. Any vehicle that does not display the 2023 window decal will be stopped by the gate attendants and asked to provide the driver's name and destination address. Property owners also have the option of using an Easy Entry gate transmitter to enter the automated gates. Please contact the SWRA office if you have not received your 2023 vehicle window decals or would like to purchase an electronic gate transmitter.



# GARBAGE CAN REMINDERS



As the temperatures warm up and owners return to StillWaters for the summer season, please remember trash cans cannot be left on the roadside before Tuesday morning and must be removed from the roadside within 24 hours of

being emptied. Owners who move their trash cans to the roadside before Tuesdays or leave them out more than 24 hours after they are emptied may be charged \$25 for each day the trash can is in violation of the rules. For owners who are only in StillWaters on the weekends or who do not want to roll a heavy trash can up a steep driveway, SWRA offers a trash can service where we will roll your trash can out to the roadside on Tuesday and return it after it has been emptied. The cost of the rollout service is \$125 per year.


