From The Board:

Labor Day Weekend signals the end of summer and is the last hurrah for summer fun for many in our community. SWRA has continued to make our planned contributions to the reserve fund, ensuring we are preparing for future repairs and improvements. Overall, SWRA is financially sound and positioned well for the remainder of the year.

September is a great time to plant trees, spring-flowering bulbs and shrubs as the soil remains warm for root establishment. So as fall arrives the SWRA Board and Staff will continue with projects such as completing some updates at the Gate 34 entrance area and other landscape maintenance.

Your SWRA Board and staff members have been busy this year doing some deep reviews and updates on multiple insurance policies and coverage, revising the SWRA Employee handbook, revising our annual employee review process and procedures, evaluating and reworking management contracts with

Architectural Review Committee

Thank You to the StillWaters ARC Committee for Their Dedication and Service.

The StillWaters Residential Association would like to extend a heartfelt thank you to the members of the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for their outstanding dedication, service, and commitment to our community. The committee plays a critical role in maintaining the integrity, beauty, and long-term value of StillWaters by thoughtfully overseeing and approving all exterior property changes and new construction projects.

The ARC, composed of five dedicated volunteer members and 2 StillWaters employees, which meets twice each month to review permit applications and monitor ongoing projects. At their most recent meeting, the committee reviewed permits, from small repairs to full home builds, each project is reviewed with care and in accordance with our covenants to ensure that all exterior changes align with the standards of our community.

So far in 2025, the ARC has issued a total of 238 permits, including:

- 26 New Homes
- 96 Remodels
- 69 New Work Projects
- 32 Tree-related Permits
- 7 Landscape Projects
- 4 Miscellaneous (e.g., dumpsters and PODs)
- 1 Infrastructure Project

On average, projects are completed in **104 days**, while new homes take approximately **269 days** to finish. These timelines reflect the scale and importance of the work being done across StillWaters, and the ARC's commitment to ensuring each project meets community standards.

The ARC plays a key role in upholding the HOA covenants, which are designed to maintain and enhance property values within our community. These regulations support the consistent upkeep, architectural integrity, and visual appeal of StillWaters, helping ensure that our neighborhood remains a welcoming and attractive place for all residents.

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
